Note for EWS :- Only those candidates will be considered in this category, who are not covered under SC, ST, BC-I, BC-II. And their family income is less than 8 lakh per annum from all sources.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-

B.A. (Hons.) :- For the B.A. Honours Degree course in any subject, it shall be necessary for a student to have obtained not less than 45% marks at the Intermediate/XIIth Class examination in the subject concerned, or in an allied subject as determined by the Academic Council.


[A candidate shall be eligible for admission to the B.A. Honours Course in any subject of Arts even though he has not studied the subject concerned at the Intermediate/ XIIth Class and if he has passed in Science or Commerce with not less than 45% marks in the aggregate.]

No Candidate shall choose Mathematics, Statistics or Geography unless he has passed the intermediate examination in the concerned subject.

B.Sc.(Hons.):- For the B.Sc. Honours Degree in any subject it shall be necessary for a student to have obtained not less than 45% marks at the intermediate/ XIIth Class examination in the subject offered for Honours study, or in an allied subject as determined by the Academic Council.

A candidate shall not choose-

- (i) Mathematics or Statistics unless he has passed the I.Sc. /XIIth Class examination in Mathematics.
- (ii) Physics unless he has passed the I.Sc./XIIth Class examination in Physics and Mathematics.
- (iii) Chemistry unless he has passed the I.Sc./ XIIth Class examination in Chemistry.

- (iv) Botany/Zoology unless he has passed the I.Sc./XII th Class examination in Biology.
- (v) Electronics unless he has passed the I.Sc. XII th Class examination in Physics and Mathematics.

B.Com.(Hons.):- For the degree of Bachelor of Commerce Honours- Degree it shall be necessary for a student to have obtained not less than 45% marks in the Commerce subject/group of subject of the Intermediate /XII th Class examination

[A student who has passed the Intermediate examination in Arts or Science shall also be eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Commerce Honours course if he has obtained a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate at the Arts or Science Intermediate /XII th examination.]

ITI:-

The students who have passed ITI examinations and have also passed 100 marks examination of Hindi & English with minimum 45% in Bihar School Examination Board, Patna will be eligible only for B.A Honours course.

DIPLOMA/POLYTECHNIC:-

A student having Diploma/Polytechnic pass certificate will be allowed to opt Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics Honours provided that he/she has obtained minimum 45% marks in the concerned subject.


Vocational (+2):-

A students will be eligible for admission in B.A. Honours course in Hindi/English or one related subject in which he/she has obtained not less than 45% marks in the concerned subject.

PASS /GENERAL COURSE:-

B.A/B.Sc/B.Com.(Gen.):- If a candidate has less than 45% marks in 12th and if he/she is not able to get Honours subject with minimum 45% marks as required may opt for the general course in the same faculty (Arts, Science & Commerce) in which he/she has passed. Change of faculty is not permissible for candidates having less than 45% marks in aggregate.

Year Gap Penalty:- 2% marks will be deducted for each gap year of passing Intermediate/XIth class upto maximum 8% in the preparation of merit list.
